2010-10802 Assault with weapon, threaten death, unlawfully in a dwelling

On Tuesday August 31, 2010 at 3:09 PM a 30 year old Innisfil woman attended at a former boyfriend's house where he lived with his father. The woman was looking for the former boyfriend and was upset when she was told by the father that his son was not home.

She then threatened to kill the father and the former boyfriend stepped in to stop her from advancing on his father. The woman then assaulted the former boyfriend in an attempt to get at his father. She then picked up a potted plant and threw it twice attempting to strike the father. She then grabbed two kitchen knives and threw both at the men striking a wall and a door. The woman then left the residence.

Neither man was injured in the attack. The woman was located a short time later and arrested. She was held for a bail hearing and is now charged with being unlawfully in a dwelling, assault, assault with a weapon and uttering death threats.

2010 - 10808 Domestic assault

On Tuesday August 31, 2010 at 7:16 PM a 50 year old Innisfil man got into an argument with his wife at their Innisfil home. The woman was holding a small child and the man pushed her causing her to fall back into furniture and sustain a small cut. The child was not injured. The man was arrested by responding officers for domestic assault. The man was transported to the police station and later released on conditions and was given a criminal court date in October.

August 30, 2010

2010-10705 Robbery

On 29th August shortly before 4.30 pm police were called to a variety store in the village of Stroud where the store clerk had been robbed by a man with a gun. The victim a 16 year old female advised police that the man entered the store, engaged her in making some minor purchases then produced a black handgun from the waistband of his pants. The robber obtained a quantity of cash, cigarettes and scratch cards before fleeing the store. The robber is described as: Male, white with dark brown hair and facial hair. Was wearing a yellow t-shirt, baseball hat and black backpack. The victim was not injured during this event.

August 28, 2010

2010-10480 - Assault, Assault Bodily Harm, Choking, Mischief under \$5000.00

South Simcoe Police have been investigating an incident of domestic assault which had occurred earlier in the week. An arrest warrant was issued for the accused a 57 year old male from Bradford. On August 26, 2010 the accused attended the south division station where he was arrested for assault. As a result of further investigation he was also charged with assault causing bodily harm, choking and mischief under five thousand dollars. He was held for a bail hearing.

August 27, 2010

2010-10288 Assault

On 21st August police patrolling the downtown Bradford core area were approached by a female who advised she had been struck by another female at a local bar. The suspect had fled the area at the time but investigation revealed her identity. On Friday the 27th of August the wanted female surrendered herself to police at the south division of the south Simcoe police. Charged with one count of assault is a 21 year old Newmarket female, she will appear in Bradford court late in September.

August 26, 2010

2010-10357 Assault, Assault with a weapon

On August 22, 2010 at approximately 3:30am South Simcoe Police Officers were called the Collings Ave. area of Bradford, regarding a man with a knife. When officers arrived a male victim advised that Accused #1 had held a knife to his throat as Accused #2 punched him several times. Descriptions were obtained. Police arrested the male believed to be Accused #2, a short time after the incident. Accused #2 was taken to the Police Station and investigation continued. By early the next morning officers had also identified the second man - Accused #1.

Accused #2 is a 26 yr old Bradford man, who faces charges of Assault and Assault with a weapon. He will appear in Bradford Court in September 2010.

Accused #1 is a 21 yr old Bradford man who will face charges of Assault, Assault with a Weapon and Weapons Dangerous. Accused #1 could not be located and a Warrant for his arrest was sought by investigating officers.

The warrant for arrest was obtained and the accused eventually surrendered himself to South Simcoe Police on the 26th of August 2010 at the South Division in Bradford. He was subsequently held pending a Bail Hearing later the same day in Barrie. The 21 year old Bradford man was later remanded in custody.

August 25, 2010

2010-10475 Warrant executed Family Responsibility Act

On Tuesday August 24, 2010 at 10:30 PM officers attended at an Innisfil residence to locate a 40 year old Innisfil man who had not paid his family support as ordered by the Courts. A warrant had been issued for the man. The man was arrested and held in custody after being taken to the Penetang jail.

August 24, 2010

2010-10425 7 Day licence seizure and vehicle impound

On Monday August 23, 2010 at 11:55 PM an officer conducting radar on Yonge St. north of Bradford, measured a vehicle travelling south bound at 57 km/h over the posted speed limit. The officer stopped the vehicle and charged the 16 year old driver, from Bradford. The youth had his licence suspended and car impounded for the next 7 days. He now faces a court date and is charged with Stunt driving under the Highway traffic act.

August 23, 2010

2010-10383 Bench Warrant Executed

On August 22, 2010 at approximately 7pm Toronto Police contacted South Simcoe Police notifying they had arrested a male on a Bench Warrant held by South Simcoe Police. South Simcoe Police attended 32 Div of Toronto Police and took custody of the male. The male, a 37 yr old North York man, had failed to appear for court , on his Possession of a Controlled Drug and Substances Act charge, on 29JUL2010 in Bradford. The male was held for a bail hearing in Barrie Court on 23AUG2010.

August 22, 2010

2010-10342 Over 80 mgs Care and Control

At approximately 12:30am on August 22, 2010 South Simcoe Police officers were conducting RIDE on Canal Rd. and Pumphouse Rd. in Bradford. A Vehicle was stopped at this time. The driver indicated he had consumed alcohol and a roadside test was given. The result of the roadside test as a fail. The male was arrested and taken to the Police Station. Breath tests at the station revealed the male was over the legal limit of alcohol in his blood to operating a vehicle. A 41 yr old Newmarket man faces a charge of Over 80 mgs. He will appear in Court in September.

2010-10357 Assault, Assault with a Weapon

On August 22, 2010 at approximately 3:30am South Simcoe Police Officers were called the Collings Ave. area of Bradford regarding a man with a knife. When officers arrived a male victim advised Accused #1 had held a knife to his throat as Accused #2 punched him several times. Descriptions were obtained. Police arrested the male believed to be Accused #2 a short time after the incident. Accused #2 was taken to the Police Station and investigation continued. By early the next morning officers had identified Accused #1. Accused #2 a 26 yr old Bradford man faces charges of Assault and Assault with a weapon. He will appear in Bradford Court in September. Accused #1 a 21 yr old Bradford man faces charges of Assault, Assault with a weapon and Weapons Dangerous. Accused #1 has not been located yet and a Warrant for his arrest in being sought.

August 21, 2010

2010-10078 Sexual Assault

On August 18, 2010 police arrested a 51 year old Bradford man and charged him with 12 counts of sexual offences against females when they were 9 yrs old. The offences took place

in 2006 and 2007. He has been released with several conditions including not to be in the presence of children under the age of 16, and not to attend pools, parks or schools.

August 20, 2010

2010-10167 Warrant- Arrest

On 18th August South Simcoe police attended an Alcona residence to check for a wanted male. Upon arrival they located the man outside the residence and arrested him on a warrant for Domestic assault. The 39 year old Innisfil man was held for bail in Barrie.

2010-10181 Warrant Arrest

On 19th August a female surrendered herself to South Simcoe police on an outstanding warrant for failing to appear in court on charges of Impaired driving and over 80 milligrams. The 49 year old Alliston woman was held for bail in Barrie.

August 19, 2010

2010-9822 Assault - Arrest Warrant Executed

On Thursday 12 August 2010, an Innisfil woman contacted South Simcoe Police to report her husband had assaulted her in their Innisfil home. No injuries were sustained. The accused left the residence prior to police attendance and continued to avoid police. As a result an arrest warrant was obtained the following day. The man was eventually located back at the home on 18 August 2010, during the evening hours and was arrested by police. He was returned to South Division and held for a Bail Hearing in Barrie on 19 August 2010. Now charged with assault is a 39 year old Innisfil man.

2010-10140 Assault

On Wednesday the 18 August 2010, an Innisfil woman contacted South Simcoe Police to report her husband had assaulted her on the 28th July 2010, in their Innisfil home, with minor injuries sustained. The accused was located this date and arrested for the offence. He was returned to the South Division, where he was later released on a Promise to Appear and an Undertaking with several conditions. Now charged with assault is a 32 year old Angus man. He will appear in a Bradford Court in September 2010.

August 17, 2010

August 16/10

2010-10048 Marine call - Drowning - Lefroy Harbour

On Monday August 16, 2010 at 3:15 PM officers were called to attend the area of Lefroy Harbour in Innisfil for a possible drowning. Officers determined that a 51 year old Richmond Hill man had taken a small inflatable tube approximately 200 ft off shore. The inflatable tube overturned and the man fell into the water. The man was not able to swim to shore and subsequently went under the surface of the water and out of view. The man's family was near by at the time. The tube was recovered by a civilian boater in the area.

Officers from the South Simcoe marine unit and York Region marine and air support attended the area and started a search for the man. The man's body was recovered from the water approximately 3 hours later. Cause of death is suspected to be drowning. The man was not wearing any type of flotation device. Weather was clear but windy at the time of the incident.

The investigation will now be followed up by the Coroner's office. An autopsy is scheduled for August 17, 2010.

Police remind all persons on the water to always wear a personal flotation device (PFD) or life jacket and not venture out alone. Make sure that someone knows where you are going and have some method of contacting people on shore if you are in distress or need assistance.

August 15, 2010

2010-9995 Federal parole warrant executed and child turned over to CAS

On Sunday August 15, 2010 at 3:30 PM South Simcoe Police were asked to check on a local Innisfil campground to locate a mother and her 18 month old child who was wanted for apprehension by the Children's aid society in Cornwall. The child was deemed to be in need of protection. The woman's older child had been apprehended earlier in the day. Officers attended and could not locate the woman or the child as they had left the campground. Officers attended later in the day, at 7:05 PM and located the child and the mother. The mother was in the company of a 34 year old man from New Brunswick who was wanted on a federal parole violation.

The child was turned over the Children's Aid. The man was arrested and held in custody on the outstanding parole warrant. The man was returned to a prison in Toronto.

August 14, 2010

2010- 9943 Assault

South Simcoe Police attended to Sunset Speed way at approx. 10:40 p.m. Saturday evening for an assault that took place in one of the racing teams PIT. A female had been punched in the face and she had broken false teeth. The investigation revealed that two race teams were bumping vehicles in the last race and an argument ensued into the PIT area of one of the teams. During the heated argument many people from both teams started to fight one another and a 51 year old Holland Landing female was struck by an unknown male. She was

transported to South Lake by family members. The investigation is continuing. No charges have been laid. All teams involved have been banned for the remainder of the season.

2010-9967 Medical Aid

Police attended to a medical Aid Call at Sunset Speedway on Yonge St Stroud at approx. 4:00 a.m on Sunday morning. Police spoke to EMS workers advising a 19 year old Holland Landing female received 3rd degree burns to her lower body as her brother poured gasoline onto a fire pit to enhance the flames to gain more heat. The victim was sitting close to the fire when her Pajama bottoms caught on fire. Family and friends ran to her aid to put the fire out. She was transported to RVH in Barrie. South Simcoe Police are still investigating.

August 13, 2010

2010-9865 Impaired Operation

On Friday, August 13th, 2010 at approx. 8:39 p.m. a South Simcoe Police officer was travelling west bound on the 7th Line of Innisfil from the 20th Sideroad when he observed an east bound black Toyota sedan travelling in the officers lane on the wrong side of the road. The officer had to make an emergency maneuver putting the police vehicle into the ditch to avoid a serious collision. The vehicle was stopped a short distance away. Police could detect an odor of alcohol. The 38 year old female Innisfil resident was arrested for Impaired care and control of a motor vehicle. The Accused was transported to the South division where she blew over twice the legal limit. She was released on a Promise to appear and has a court date in October. The officer was not hurt and the cruiser was not damaged.

2010-9891 Intoxicated in a Public Place

Police were called to a possible fight on Maple Grove Rd. in the Town of Bradford Saturday morning around 3:45 a.m. Police attended and spoke to two males and a female who advised two males came up and tried to start a fight with them. After a short scuffle both males fled the scene. One male was injured during the scuffle but later learned that he was intoxicated and fell down on his own after losing his balance. He ended up with swelling to his face from the fall. The male was transported to South Lake and later released. His friend was causing a disturbance while police were investigating and a 27 year old Bradford male ended up getting arrested for Public Intox. He was held at the south division until sober. The two males were never located.

August 12, 2010

2010-9774 Personal Injury Motor Vehicle Collision

Just after 11:00 pm on Wednesday August 11th, South Simcoe Police received a report of a motor vehicle collision on County Rd 88 just east of Highway 400 in the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury. A westbound tractor trailer had been struck by a car which was exiting Highway 400 and lost control as it was merging onto eastbound County Rd 88. The car crossed the center line and struck the tractor and trailer causing a leak in the gas tank of the tractor. There were five occupants in the car which sustained severe damage. Two parties were transported to hospital with non life-threatening injuries. Bradford West Gwillimbury Fire Service attended the scene and controlled the fuel leak from the tractor. Traffic was limited for some time until the spill could be cleaned and the road completely opened about 2.5 hours later. The driver of the car was charged with a Highway Traffic Act

offence. Both parties transported to hospital were later released after treatment and sustained only minor injuries.

2010-8236 Assault - Domestic

Shortly after 3:00 am on Thursday August 12th, South Simcoe Police responded to a report of a domestic assault at a Bradford residence. Officers determined that a 37 year old Bradford male had assaulted his common-law spouse by forcing her up against a wall. The victim did not receive any injuries. The male was charged with Assault and released on conditions that he not communicate with the victim nor attend at the residence. He has a court date in Bradford Provincial court in September to answer to the charges.

August 10, 2010

2010-9682 Impaired Care or Control, Drive over 80 mgs

South Simcoe Police stopped a motor vehicle driving in the Town of Innisfil. After a brief conversation with the driver, a 39 year old male from Innisfil, was arrested for Impaired Care and Control. He was taken to the south division station and later released on a promise to appear. He was charged with impaired care and control and drive over 80 mgs.

August 9, 2010

2010-9632 Possession of Stolen Property

On Sunday August 8th 2010, at 5:30 PM the South Simcoe Police Service received a 911 call regarding three males riding around a field in Bradford on a golf cart. Investigating officers approached and the three males fled on foot. A short track with officers and K9 resulted in the two adults and one young offender being arrested for possession of stolen property. The three Bradford men were released on a promise to appear and an undertaking entered into before an officer .

2010-9629 Utter Threats and Assault

On Sunday August 8th 2010, at 4:50pm South Simcoe officers attended a rooming house in Bradford to deal with a disturbance. When they arrived a male suspect was being restrained by a resident. Investigation found that the accused a 27 year old Bradford man had made threats to kill another person. When the officers were making the arrest the suspect struck one of the officers, the officer was not injured. The accused was held for bail Monday August 9th 2010 at the Barrie City court house.

August 7, 2010

2010-9556 Assault

South Simcoe police attended to an assault on Lockhart road at approx. 3:30 a.m. The investigation revealed that a male was knocked out as he was punched in the head area and then fell to the ground. He was transported to RVH as it appeared to have serious head injuries. The 21 year old Barrie resident was visiting friends at a party when the incident took place. After being checked out it was determined the victims injuries were not serious. The investigation is continuing. Charges for assault causing bodily harm are pending!

August 6, 2010

2010-9441 Theft/Possession stolen Property

On Thursday, August 5th, 2010 South Simcoe Police attended to the Bradford Wall Mart on Holland St. Officers were directed to a female who was believed to have stolen merchandise from the store. The security advised officers that she walked out without paying for many items. When police tried to arrest her she struck the officer. She was eventually taken into custody. The 31 year old Bradford resident was later released on a Promise to Appear and released with conditions. She has a court date in September.

August 5, 2010

2010-9424 Theft under \$5000 / Possession under \$5000 / Breach Probation

Just before 11:00 pm on Wednesday August 4th, police were advised of the theft of a bicycle from an Alcona gas station. The victim of the theft reported that he left his bike outside the convenience store/gas bar. A male was observed to take the bike from the store. The theft was also caught on the store video. The male suspect was identified and officers attended at his residence and recovered the stolen bicycle. Charged with theft, possession of stolen property and breach probation is a 47 year old Alcona male. The male was transported to the South Simcoe Police South Division where he was processed and held for a bail hearing in Barrie Court on Thursday August 5th. The bicycle was photographed by police for return to the owner.

August 4, 2010

2010-9308 Possession of a Controlled Substance

On Monday the 2nd of August police were called to a Cookstown mall where a man had left behind a bag in the lot, when the bag was searched for identification a quantity of illegal drugs were found. Police attended and the owner was called to retrieve his property. When the man attended he was arrested. Charged with possession of a controlled substance is a 23 year old Toronto man. He was released and will appear in court in September.

2010-9337 Domestic Assault

On Tuesday the 3rd of Aug a complaint of domestic assault was received in Bradford where a common law husband had struck his wife with an open hand across her face. The 64 year old man was arrested and charged with assault. He will appear in court in September.

2010-9365 Assault with a Weapon, Weapon Dangerous.

On Tuesday the 3rd of August police were called to a Bradford street where it was reported that a man was chasing another man with a knife on the street. Upon police arrival it was discovered that the accused a 36 year old man had been drinking and got into an argument with his father in law. The argument led into fisticuffs and ended with the accused chasing his father in law with a kitchen knife. The accused will appear in Bradford court in September. No serious injuries were sustained during this occurrence.

August 3, 2010

2010-9295 Assault, Assault with a Weapon, Mischief to Property

On Monday the 2nd of August 2010, a female from Bradford attended the South Simcoe Police Service to report an assault by her previous male tenant that occurred on 31 July 2010, at her Bradford home. She alleged the subject struck her with a cane causing injuries and then damaged her personal property inside the apartment. Officers later traced the man, at an address in Newmarket, where he was placed under arrest for the offences. He was then returned to the South Division and held overnight until his bail hearing on 3rd August 2010 in Barrie. Now charged is a 46 year old Newmarket man with the offences of assault, assault with a weapon and mischief to property.

August 1, 2010

2010-9223 Assault

On the 31st July 2010, at 6:35 PM South Simcoe Police officers attended a Stroud residence in the Town of Innisfil to investigate an assault allegation. Investigating officers arrested a 30 year old Female with assault in relation to a female dispute. The accused was transported to the police station and held for bail Sunday August 1st 2010.

2010-9256 Assault

On the 1st of August 2010, at 3:30 AM officers were dealing with a noise complaint at a residence in the Town of Bradford. Officers on scene heard shouting coming from a near by street, further investigation found a 25 year old Bradford male assaulting his girlfriend. The accused was arrested and transported to the police station and held in custody for a bail hearing August 1st 2010.

The toddler was reunited with his parents and transported to a local hospital by ambulance as a precaution.

Missing Person Curtis Barry 10-8628 - UPDATE

The South Simcoe Police Service continue to search for Missing Person Curtis Barry in Bradford. He has been missing since Monday July 19, 2010.

On Tuesday July 27, 2010 a second air search will be conducted with the assistance of the York Regional Police helicopter during the early evening hours. The search will focus in the area just North and to the East where Curtis Barry's dogs were located.

Police continue to investigate leads and follow-up on tips as reported by the public. To date there has been no sign of the whereabouts of Curtis Barry.

It is anticipated that the South Simcoe Police will again conduct one more ground search with K9 units in specific locations on Wednesday July 28, 2010 along the Southern portion of the search area.

July 26, 2010

UPDATE.....

The South Simcoe Police Service continues to search for Missing Person Curtis Barry.

The Missing Collie/Retriever dog that was still outstanding has been located on July 26, 2010. The dog had been picked up by a motorist on Monday July 19, 2010 at 11am in the area of Disette Street and Bridge Street in Bradford. This was also in the area where Curtis Barry's other dog (Germain Short-haired pointer) was located last week. The Collie/Retriever had been dropped off at the OSPCA in Aurora and it had since then been transferred to Georgina. The person who located the dog and dropped it off had gone on vacation and returned on July 26, 2010 and reported the incident to police.

On Monday July 26, 2010 one week after Curtis BARRY went missing, officers conducted a canvass of motor vehicles in the area where Curtis Barry is known to have walked. Officers stopped several vehicles during the daytime hours on Disette Street at Industrial Road in Bradford to canvass motorists in attempts to gather further witnesses or any information that would assist in the search. In addition, a ground search was conducted in the area E/B of Artesian Industrial Parkway and the 9th Line of Bradford. Officers on foot also searched the areas W/B on Bridge Street from Disette Street to Canal Road (on North side).

The South Simcoe Police Service will be continuing to search in concentrated areas over the next few days.

2010- 8923 Breach of Undertaking

On July 25, 2010 South Simcoe Police were called to an Innisfil residence for a dispute. The reporting person was having difficulty with a 15 year old male who was residing at the residence. Upon investigation the police arrested and charged a 15 male from Keswick for Breach of undertaking. He was held for a bail hearing/

2010-8940 Domestic Assault, Mischief

On July 25, 2010 South Simcoe Police were called to Sunset Speedway for a domestic incident. There was a benefit concert going on at the time, Upon investigating the incident police arrested a 19 year old male from Lefroy for domestic assault and mischief. He was held for a bail hearing .

2010-8810 Sexual Assault, Theft under \$5000

South Simcoe Police were contacted by a female who reports that she met a male on an on-line dating site. After some brief chats via the computer she decided to meet him in person. On their first encounter the female alleges she was sexually assaulted and had some property stolen. A 38 year old male with no fixed address was arrested and charged with sexual assault and theft under five thousand dollars. He was held for a bail hearing.

Mr. BARRY's Collie dog is also still missing. The German pointer has been returned to the family after being found on Dissette St. in Bradford on Monday July 19, 2010.

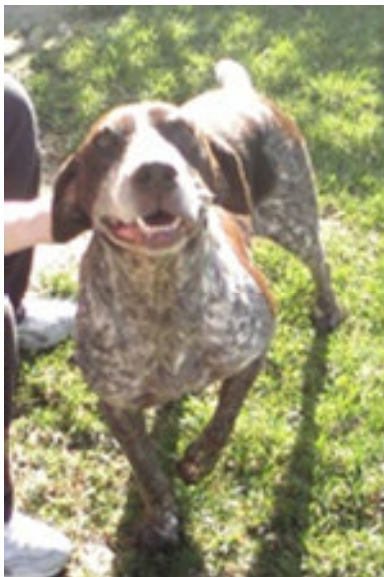
